



SafeNest has been at the forefront of ending domestic and sexual violence in Southern Nevada for 44 years. What sets them apart is the commitment to treating the entire continuum of violence from prevention to protection to empowerment. Not only providing a discreet, safe shelter for victims of abuse, but SafeNest is also the only nonprofit in the Valley to provide resources for batterers to address the cycle of abuse at the root. Across all programs, SafeNest provides direct services to more than 20,000 clients across Clark County annually.

# Giving Hope to Ukraine: Our Initiatives and Progress


Requirement for support doesn't always arrive in a structured time and type format. Part of our posture has been to remain flexible and collaborative when the time for need comes. In March of 2022, Lighthouse Charities launched the Ukrainian Refugee Relief Efforts program in response to the growing requirement to support refugees fleeing from the ongoing war. Lighthouse were spearheading Ukrainian refugee efforts in Nevada and working closely with partner agencies at the U.S. / Mexico border. Refugee families, many of whom are parents or single parents traveling with their children, have been permitted to cross the border into the United States under humanitarian parole status, and scores of refugee families made their way to Southern Nevada with the support of Lighthouse Charities. When asked for support from Lighthouse, we moved quickly to adopt 3 refugee families, providing safe housing, food, clothing, transportation, and other necessities for the families. We have been humbled by the love, commitment, and resourcefulness they have shown. With ambitions to learn and improve upon their English and to become productive members of our Southern Nevada communities, the families have secured jobs, schooling, and are each now in stable positions no longer requiring ongoing support. Lincoln Dynamic Foundation is proud of how far they have come and were honored to ride along on this journey with them. Founded in the U.S. through grassroots action in 1951, The Nature Conservancy (TNC) has grown to become one of the most effective and wide-reaching environmental organizations in the world. Thanks to more than a million members and the dedicated efforts of their diverse staff and over 400 scientists, they impact conservation in 76 countries and territories: 37 by direct conservation impact and 39 through partners.


Within the field of materials science and engineering, numerous research endeavors aspire to address sustainability related issues. Many of these efforts are focused on 'sustainable technologies' such as renewable energy system technologies (e.g., solar and energy storage technologies), and energy-efficiency technologies (e.g., LED light bulbs). What is often not recognized, however, is that these 'sustainable' technologies require the use of materials and manufacturing processes that might not be 'sustainable'. Thus, there is a need to investigate 'sustainable development of materials' through the lens of not just energy efficiency, but also chemical footprint and potential human and environmental effects.

To address these knowledge gaps, 'World Institute for Sustainable Development of Materials' (WISDOM) at the University of California, Irvine (UCI) was created, with \$1M donation by the Lincoln Dynamic Foundation.

The WISDOM mission is to advance interdisciplinary research, education and knowledge translation for innovation, evaluation and adoption of technologies that utilize nontoxic, safer chemicals and generate fewer greenhouse gas emissions.

WISDOM places UCI at the forefront of discovery at the complex interface of green chemistry, materials selection and design, life cycle assessment, toxicology, alternatives assessment, and public policy.


# 2022 in Review: The Year's Biggest Achievements and Moments
