WE HAD A BABY

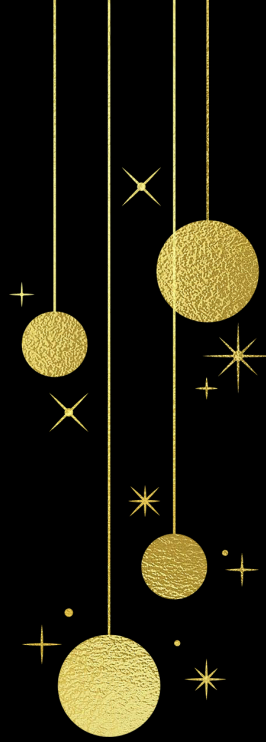
